



Soft Tissue Management with Rehabilitative Devices

for acute to chronic pathologies. This non-invasive treatment encourages practitioners' treatments to 'hold' for longer and to rehabilitate in a pain free environment. This innovative analgesic can complement most treatments of musculoskeletal pathologies. Understanding the basic anatomy of fascia, the integument nervous systems are imperative in comprehending how the tape can create biochemical changes within in the body. There will be a special anatomical focus on the process of mechanotransduction and myofascial signaling system.

Dr. Jennifer Illes is a dynamic communicator who brings 15 years of combined clinical and academic experience. She is a graduate of New York Chiropractic College and her experience includes treating professional athletes with sports related injuries. She is an expert on extremity adjusting and is passionate about educating healthcare physicians. Chronic Spine Pain and Rehabilitation

Utilizing Laboratory Testing in the Evaluation and Management of Musculoskeletal Pain

Chiropractors are more commonly becoming the entry point to healthcare for their patients. This has increased the importance of utilizing laboratory testing in our evaluation and management.
